The Veterans Future Wellness Center (VFWC) is building primary healthcare management networks for service-connected disabled veterans living abroad on long-term visas and enrolled in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Foreign Medical Program (VA FMP).



VFWC is seeking an initial investment of **\$4,500,000** to establish the framework, policies, procedures, and operational ecosystem needed to align VA FMP claims processing and documentation requirements with host nation medical service providers. This investment will enable participating providers to connect their treatment modules to standardized documentation procedures and successfully complete the reimbursement process.



Our networks connect American veterans with service-related disabilities to the medically necessary continuum of care offered by qualified host nation medical service providers. American physicians serve as consulting subject matter experts with direct experience supporting service members and veterans with service-connected disabilities. Working in partnership with host nation medical providers, they help develop Individualized Medical Treatment Plans (IMTPs) tailored to each veteran's unique combination of service-related conditions.



Under the leadership of Founder and Chief Executive Officer Timothy Ray Hardison, VFWC has strengthened its readiness through participation and certification in VIP START and the PenFed Foundation Incubator. These experiences have provided valuable insight into federal contracting processes and strategies that position the company for future collaboration opportunities as the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs advances implementation of the Foreign Medical Program modernization legislation enacted in January 2025.



VFWC's mission is to establish primary healthcare management networks capable of delivering coordinated, individualized treatment solutions for service-connected disabled veterans residing abroad. The company is uniquely positioned as a wholly American-owned, service-connected disabled veteran-owned small business operating outside the United States with the capacity to support U.S. Government Accountability Office recommendations for improving the VA Foreign Medical Program and integrating host nation medical practitioners into the claims and reimbursement process.
